## **IX-RS Sub Master Door Release Settings**


### **GENERAL OVERVIEW:**

The IX-RS audio only sub station can be configured to receive incoming calls from door stations and trigger door release. These settings add features to the station while still maintaining its primary functionalities.


#### Calling the IX-RS **Table View** 1.1 - Station View Switch from Table View to Station View Station View by clicking the Station View button in the top left corner of Support Tool. - Call Settings - Station Information 1.2 - Called Stations Called Stations (Master Station Called Stations (Door/Sub St Expand Call Settings and click Called Call Origination Stations (Door/Sub Stations). 
