Introduction

When the IX-MV7 master station detects an issue while executing line supervision or device check, the IXW-MA adaptor can be programmed to trigger relay output 1. This relay will also trigger if the IX-MV7 doing the supervision goes offline. The relay can be connected to an alarm panel or light to alert the user of an issue within the system. This guide will show how to configure the system using IX Support Tool in Table View.

IXW-MA Support Tool Settings

The IXW-MA will need to be configured using the IX Support Tool software to allow for the supervision functionality.

IXW-MA - Identification

The station number of the IXW-MA will need to end with 99 for the supervision feature to be enabled. Using IX Support Tool, expand the **Station Information** tree and select **Identification**. Assign a three to five digit number to the IXW-MA that ends with 99 (i.e. 199, 1099, etc.).

IXW-MA - Relay Output

Expand the **Option Input / Relay Output Settings** tree and select **Relay Output**. Change the function for Relay Output 1 for the IXW-MA to Contact Change SIF Event. Scroll right and select the master station for Relay Output 1 Contact Change SIF Event.

IX-MV7 Support Tool Settings

The IX Support Tool software will also be used to configure the IX-MV7 master station's Line Supervision and Device Check operations. A signal will also be sent to the IXW-MA when a problem is detected.

IX-MV7 - SIF

The IX-MV7 sends the IXW-MA a SIF event when a problem is detected on the system. Expand the **Function Settings** tree and select **SIF**. Set SIF Functionality for the IX-MV7 master station to **Enable** and then enter the following for the SIF Settings:

IX-MV7 - Line Supervision and Device Check

The IX Series uses the Line Supervision and Device Check operations to check the connection status and functionality of the stations in the system. Both of these operations can be manually initiated on the IX-MV7 master station and automatically initiated based on a set interval or schedule. To configure this, expand the **Station Settings** tree and select **Line Supervision**. Under **Line Supervision Interval** and **Device Check Interval**, use the **Test Interval** drop-downs to designate how often each test occurs, then create a schedule if a **Daily** or **Weekly** interval was selected.
